



## **“Versatility Entry” Program**

### **Title Requirements :**

**Purpose :** To promote the versatile nature of the Leonberger. The Versatility Entry Program recognizes those Leonbergers that have begun working towards a level of accomplishment as versatile working dogs.

7 points from 3 categories are required for the “Versatility Entry” title

**Obedience**, 1 point for each activity

1. Certified Completion of Training Course
2. Certified participation in canine oriented workshop/seminar
3. Urban Dog
4. Canine Good Neighbor / Canine Good Citizen

**Soundness**, 1 point for each certification, **(Please note tested dogs do NOT have to be “normal”. The testing is for the owner’s information and should be done before participating in active sports)**

1. OFA, OVC
2. TT, TC
3. Ophthalmologist tested
4. VWD tested
5. Thyroid
6. Heart

**Stock work** (1 point)

Herding instinct tested (HC, HIC, HIT) only one Herding Instinct test may be claimed.

**Miscellaneous** (1 point for each activity)

1. Hunting Dog\*
2. Water Rescue\*
3. Coaching\*
4. Modeling\*, Acting\*
5. Drill team\*, Square Dancing\*, Free Style Dance\*
6. Public Relations\* (Demos, Parades and/or Seminars)

\*These activities should be verified in writing by an official (dog club official, school principal, licensed judge, park ranger, etc.) unrelated to the owners of the dog. To apply, photocopies of titles, degrees, certifications and/or verifications (including videos) should be submitted to the club secretary along with a processing fee of \$5.00 for members, and \$10.00 for non-LCO members per title applied for.

Unofficial documented activities not listed will be considered with verification at the discretion of the Club.
